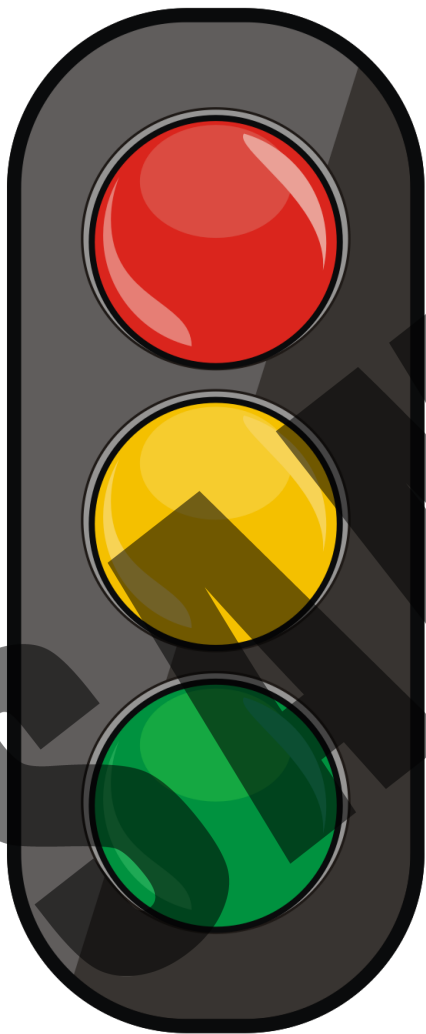
#### Questions and Activities:
