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Facebook Privacy Settings

Here's how to change your privacy settings on Facebook:

Step 1: Log into your Facebook account

The first step is to log into your Facebook account using your email address and password.

Step 2: Access the Privacy Settings and Tools menu

Once you're logged in, click on the down arrow at the top right corner of your screen. This will open a drop-down menu. Click on "Settings & Privacy" and then select "Privacy Shortcuts" from the drop-down menu.

Step 3: Review and adjust your privacy settings

- On the Privacy Shortcuts page, you'll see a list of options to review and adjust your privacy settings. Here are some of the key options you may want to consider:
- Who can see your future posts? This setting controls who can see your posts in the future. You can choose to make your posts public, visible only to friends, or visible to a custom list of people.
- Review your activity log. This option allows you to review all of your past activity on Facebook and make changes to who can see each post or activity.
- Limit who can see past posts. This option allows you to change the privacy settings for all of your past posts at once.
- Who can send you friend requests? This setting controls who can send you friend requests on Facebook.
- Who can look you up using the email address or phone number you provided? This setting controls who can find your Facebook profile by searching for your email address or phone number. We suggest you set this to "only me".
- Who can see your friends list? This setting controls who can see the list of people you're friends with on Facebook. We suggest you set this to "only me".

- Who can see your profile information? This setting controls who can see your basic profile information, like your name, profile picture, and cover photo.

Step 4: Save your changes

Once you've adjusted your privacy settings, be sure to click the "Save Changes" button at the bottom of the page.

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
